Ten Ways Every Christian Can Strengthen Their Church

These are the attributes of church members who are growing in the Lord and helping to strengthen their church family.

1. Stay—Learn to stick. *Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.* Heb 10:25

(There are times God moves people. But don't allow an offense with another Christian or backsliding in your own heart to keep you from your church family.)

2. Sweet Spirit—Love your church.

And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works. Heb 10:24

3. Stewardship—Give liberally to God and man. *But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.* —2 Corinthians 9:6

4. Separation—Live in a way that is distinctly for God in this world.

Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you. —2 Corinthians 6:17

5. Stick with Scriptures—Read, study and hear the preaching of God's Word.

Make it your ultimate authority. *For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.* Heb 4:12

6. Sold out—Be fully committed to the things of the Lord, your marriage and family, and your church family. And Jesus said unto him, "No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God." Lk 9:62
