Keep reminding them of these things.
Warn them before God against quarreling
about words; it is of no value, and only
ruins those who listen. **2 Tim 2:14**

Warn a divisive person once, and then
warn him a second time. After that, have
nothing to do with him. **Titus 3:10**

It is a rare thing for a person to realize
they fit the category of being a quarrelsome
and divisive person. In fact, the ones that
are being described by Paul in the verses
above, were probably of the opinion that
they were the perfect disciple.

Certainly it is important to constantly
check our teaching and conduct, but when
one never sees any good, nor encourages
anything short of perfection, something is
wrong. Perhaps, you had a parent or a
teacher or a coach, who constantly nit-
picked everything you did. Never a word
to encourage or positive suggestion, just
criticism. You could make the best dress
ever, or score the winning point or break a
world's record, but not so much as an "atta
boy." Instead you got, "if you had only..."

If we have that for a background, it is
hard to break the cycle. Paul said, give
them two warnings and then avoid them.
The quarreling, divisive person has been
programmed by their life. It is as hard as
breaking an addiction, to stop being one
who constantly berates.

Remember the story of a family driving
home after Sunday worship: the father is
expressing dissatisfaction with every part
of the worship: songs, sermon, prayers,
communion. Till his son innocently asks,
"but, wasn't it a good show for a dollar?"

Find something good to say those around
you. Do they have a pleasant smile, or did
they work hard, or encourage you with their
words, or help you in a time of need?

Let us not be the slumped over person,
who snarls at others to sit up straight

free from the FCC, a most amazing gadget.

It allows a deaf person, like myself, to use the
telephone to call or receive calls, both local and
long distance and I think both cell and land lines.
It's been 10+ years that I have been deaf so I need
to learn to talk all over again and in need of practice.

If your name is in the church directory, you may
expect a call from me - if you cannot think of
something to say, just count like 1,2,3,4,5,6,7, 8,9,10.

It also has voicemail which should be renamed
scriptmail because what you say comes to me in
script on a small screen attached to my CapTel phone.

I do have a problem recording a message to you,
because your voicemail normally says after the Beep
record your message to me - well I don't hear the
Beep so I have to guess an adequate amount to time.
I am also aware that busy people sometimes use voice
mail to screen calls, including my number one son,
with him it's not sometimes, it's all the time and I
haven't figured out how to get to him.

is requesting boys’ no show socks (any size).


The no show socks can be placed in the Box Labeled “Children’s Home of Lubbock” in the foyer. They will be collected by Thursday, May 17th.
