The mushrooming of Community churches in the last twenty years has caused some to ask, "what is a Community church?" This is a short effort to answer.

Young adults were leaving home and did not want to be connected to the church of their youth. It may have been for a variety of reasons. Perhaps, there was a lot of fighting and dividing in their church. Or they did not like the denominational demands or the division that was there, when young adults were thinking of unity of everyone loving everyone. No matter the causes, it was observed and local churches started to make some changes.

Several denominational churches in various cities dropped the denominational name from their street sign and advertisements. Rather than "Grace (denomination) Church," they became "Grace Church." Others may have changed to "Grace Community Church." Truthfully, they did not drop their affiliation with their denomination, but hid it deeply in their literature or web site. The majority of these were Pentecostalist or evangelical, both highly emotional in their worship and doctrine. Some would say, "better felt than told."

Then began a plethora of denominations that were created. Many of these were identical to established denominations, but a preacher/pastor started his own for the purpose of maintaining control and in some cases, lining his own pocket.

The New Testament does not give an official name. There are several terms used in the NT, including: *churches of Christ*, used by Paul in Rom 16:16. It is biblical and Restoration churches began to use it. It is helpful when visiting elsewhere because we use the same name. But, it is a challenge when many see us as a denomination for using the same name.
