We extend our heartfelt sympathy to Keith Russell and families on the death of Keith's mother, Shirley Russell, who passed away Thursday, August 2, 2018.

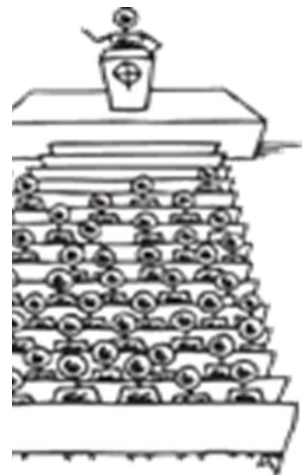
