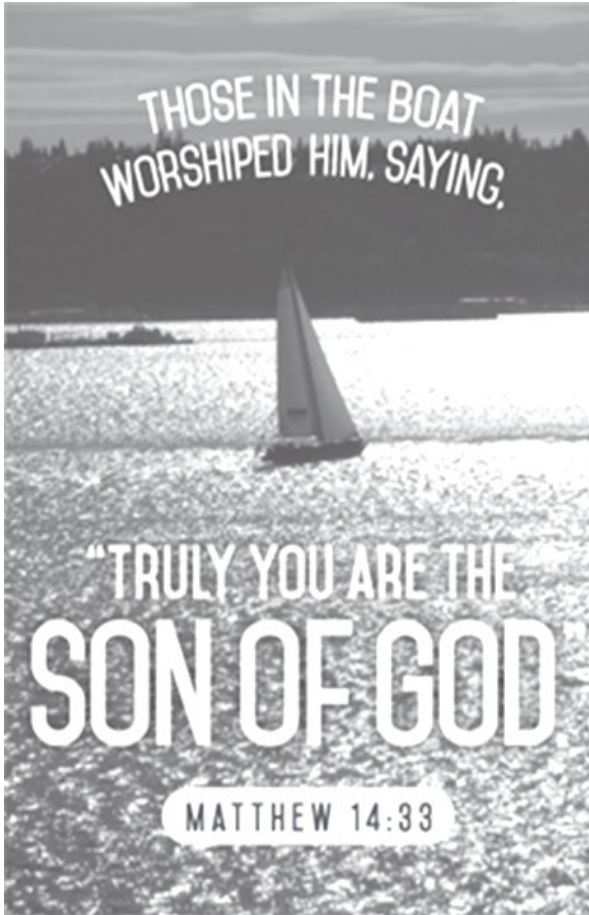

You have made a difference in the lives of others with your faith in Jesus Christ. In most likelihood, you don't even have a clue of the number people and the size of the impact. In fact, it is possible that you don't even know some of the people because they were on the peripheral of your life or just observed you from afar.

You made a difference because of the way you lived: the way you acted and the way you re-acted. People are watching you as you go about your daily life. You blessed their lives without ever knowing you were a positive influence. That's good.

There have been other times when you did everything in your power to influence another in a positive way and they would not listen. They refused, in fact, resented your efforts to motivate them to do good. These are the ones we tend to remember – the failures. Receive this as a reminder to remember the good you have done with your example of godliness, faithfulness, kindness, and the courage to stay the course. Even if you don't know all the people or ways you have blessed them. Accept that you have and rejoice in that knowledge.

However, the real purpose here is to encourage you to contact those who have blessed you and let them know you still remember the blessing they were. First, make a list, perhaps in chronological order. Who molded you with their influence to be a better person: in school, at your first job, or in your career? Will there be 1 or 10?

You will bless them with a note, email or phone call to say thanks. Even better, you will bless one who has blessed you. Start today.
