Little choices today will make a dramatic difference in our life in the future. Do you need to improve the little choices in your life? Put Jesus first, even in the little ways.

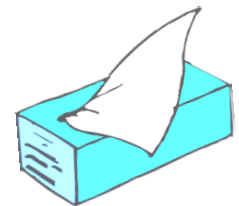
