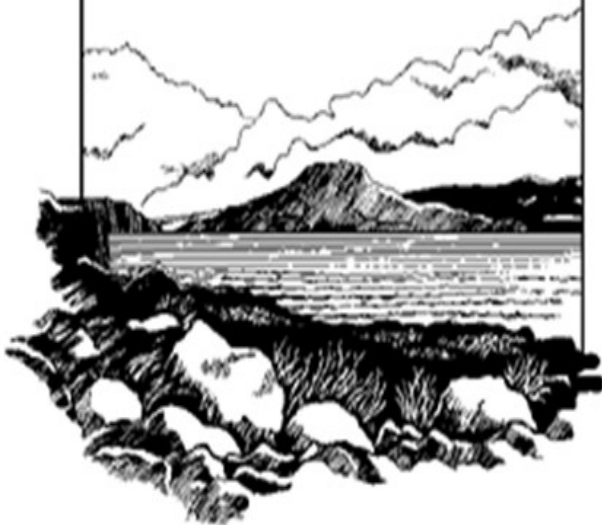

These are the kind of headlines that are used to lure us into web sites and get us to open emails called "Spam." These are usually junk advertising and often malware that contains a computer virus designed to mess up our computer and then sell a program to removed the virus it installed.

In many ways, advertising, junk mail, spam email mimic Satan. Promising more than they intend to deliver, just to lure us in and snap the trap. "Gotcha."

Temptation in its usual meaning is bad. It is made to be appealing, but we know it is not going to be good. Still, we try it. As in the fall of Adam and Eve, the devil uses specious arguments, delaying techniques and says, "you need to try it to find out."

All too frequently we are convinced to give in to sin, then even worse, we stay in sin. Addiction is generally looked on with disdain because it is not what we do. We do not understand how a person could be trapped in a sin that does not appeal to us. Jesus spoke of this when he corrected the Jews who were critical of others who had a speck in their eye, while the critic had a beam in his/her own eye.

We see the sin in others, but the sin that is in our own life is overlooked. We need to be honest with ourselves and avoid temptations that seem harmless.

On the other hand, some brethren are too hard on themselves, not seeing the good they do and the blessing they are to others. This is still Satan working on us, if he can't pull you into temptation of sin, he will seek to drag you down with dismay for some perceived spiritual lack. He does not care how he gets us off track: with sin or a guilt feeling for not being perfect. Just continue to do your best.

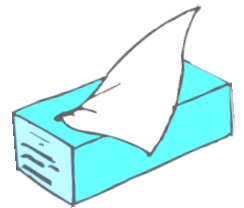
