A good name is more desirable than great riches; to be esteemed is better than silver or gold. Prov 22:1

How does a person come by a good name? Does it come from one action? A series of actions? Or a lifetime?

Alvin York was the most decorated man of WW1. He was offered a small fortune in movie deals, high level jobs with large corporations, but he turned them down because he would not profit from his service to his country in a way his fellow soldiers could not. He only agreed to the movie *Sargent York* because he thought it might encourage others to serve in WW2.

Harry S. Truman completed his terms as President and returned to his modest home in Missouri. He was offered high level jobs with corporations, which he refused by saying, you don't want me, you want the presidency and it is not for sale.

Each of us, including York and Truman, have had days when we excelled and times when we failed. Our "good name" is the result of the accumulation of our lives. We are not one act, even if it stands out to others. A single act of kindness and love may endear us to an individual, but the life long service to God and fellow man builds a reputation of a good name to those who were not even the recipient of that love.

A good name is available to all who will live for Jesus. Wealth, education, even popularity or celebrity will escape most of us, but a good name can be had by all. The honest, respectful, caring person will be honored by friends and even enemies. So, we should focus on being the kind of person that is respected by others, even if we do not possess wealth.

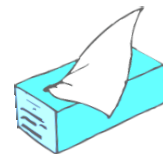
