Praise be to the Lord, for he showed his wonderful love to me when I was in a besieged city. In my alarm I said, "I am cut off from our sight!" yet you heard my cry for mercy when I called to you for help. Love the Lord, all his saints! The Lord preserved the faithful, but the proud he pays back in full. Be strong and take heart, al you who hope in the Lord. Psalm 31.

This is a wonderful psalm where David expresses his determination to remain faithful to God, but also asks for help in his pledge to be strong. David often says what everyone of feels from time to time. This psalm is one of those.

Perhaps you remember a time when you were excited for the Lord Jesus Christ and would frequently talk to your friends about Jesus. What has happened? Well, it has happened to everyone! We become involved in other things, we may even find that our faith has weakened, or maybe we think that what we do doesn't matter.

David speaks of a besieged city, your life is besieged by Satan everyday. Satan does not give up with his relentless effort to slow you down and even get you to quit serving your Savior. On occasion you are attacked by the roaring lion of evil. Alternately, you are approached by the subtle serpent to be lured so sweetly away for your Savior. Many times you are besieged by both the roaring lion and the subtle serpent.

David cried out, be merciful to me, O Lord, for I am in distress; my eyes grow weak with sorrow, my sould and my body with grief. (9) He knew he had failed with his claim to be strong and courageous. He wanted help to get back on track.

It is time to get back on track, to *Be strong and take heart, all you who hope in the Lord*. What do you need to do to renew the pledge you made to Jesus? How may you make your life what you want it to be for Jesus? Ask Jesus, *Let me not be put to shame*, that is what David did.

Building Faith in Children

It is difficult to imagine a parent that does not want the best for their child. Yes, there a few who are a sad anomaly, but just as sad are the parents who say they want the best for their child, but do nothing to follow through. When we say we want our child to be happy, but act abusively, we are lying. We cannot talk one way and act another and expect a positive result.

If a Christian wants to build faith in their child, how do they do it?

The answer is somewhat obvious. First, be the example. Be the best follower of Jesus that you can be. A child sees the parent is all kinds of situations: when we are tired, hungry, angry, happy, winning and losing. A child sees the parent at the best and worst times of life. Parents must be the best they can be at all times, but when you fail, be quick to repent, get back up and keep striving forward.

Second, give your child the chance to learn. Don't just tell them to pray, pray with them. Let them pray before

help last year and in advance for this year.



We brag of their being in a school play or team. Tell of how they learned the books of the Bible or finished reading a book of the Bible. Let them see you happy for their progress.

Children are a great blessing from God. Treat them well and teach them well, so they will be a blessing to the world. While John is writing to those who are his spiritual children, these words are just as true for our earthly children. 3 John 4 *I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth*.
