

The book of Joshua is filled with challenges and encouragement for those who believe. The last two chapters are especially poignant when Joshua writes, "Now I am about to go the way of all the earth." He understood that he had lived a long and faithful life which would soon come to an end. He had things to say before his life ended and he is saying them.

The many admonitions he has previously given in this book are in many ways summed up when he writes, "But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord." He pledges that his descendants will serve the Lord. This is likely because he knew of their faith in God and his faith that they would share with generations to come.

It can be a hard thing to continue our faith in Jesus to the next generation. It is not a blood line that is inherited. We teach and try to be an example, but we are flawed and some see only the flaws. And what of the generations to come? It doesn't take many generations and we don't even know the names of our ancestors, much less about their faith in Jesus. Will our family have faith in one hundred years from now?

May the following suggestion be useful to you in continuing the growth of faith in your family.

Create and leave your own letter for your family. In this day and age of technology you could even make a video that could be copied and given to each grand child. First, identify yourself: name, birth date, parents. One hundred years from now, they won't know who you are unless you tell them.

Then tell them why you are a Christian: you believe in Jesus Christ and are a part of churches of Christ because they seek to do just what the New Testaments teaches, no more, no less. Explain the plan of salvation and how you were born again. Tell how it is your great desire for them to do the same and follow Jesus.

Jesus Christ is the greatest treasure we can pass down, but it cannot be inherited.

Sunday Morning Sermon Speaker - Charles Clodfelter

Sermon: Leadership is a worthy ambition

Scripture: 1 Tim 3:1

PORNOGRAPHY

Pornography is the sexually explicit writings and visual stimulation whose primary purpose is to cause sexual arousal. Porn has been around for centuries, most likely from the beginning. Pompeii in Italy was destroyed by a volcanic eruption in 79 AD and buried under ash and pumice. This preserved the city for later archaeological efforts that discovered it was a sexual playground with porn on many walls.

Our nation was founded on what is called Judeo-Christian principles. Porn has been limited through law, but not excluded. Freedom of speech is the issue for those who want to have porn. One case was taken to the Supreme Court in 1964 during which Justice Potter Steward said "I can't define pornography, but I know it when I see it."

Pornography is harmful to society. First it is hurtful to men, the largest users. It destroys the sense of relationship with wives, daughters, women in general. They become objects to be used and controlled, the idea of connection with the individual is not real. When another human being begins to be just a thing and not a person, their world is out of shape.

The same could be said of women who use porn,

but a greater harm may be toward those who find themselves the objects of porn with no personal worth or relationship. Many in the "Sex Industry" are there against their will.


