

Sunday Morning Sermon Speaker - Charles Clodfelter Sermon: Leadership is a worthy ambition

Scripture: 1 Tim 3:1

Preaching is Hard

We are not talking about the fact that public speaking is the number one fear of most people, even before death. Nor of the effort that is required to research the subject and put it together in a way that is understandable to all. Preaching is hard because you do not know if an impact is being made on the hearers.

There is an old story of a preacher moving to a new congregation and preaching his first sermon. The next week he preached the exact same sermon. The next week the same sermon. The following weeks he did it again and again. After six weeks the church leaders met and asked if he was going to preach a different sermon. He replied, when you start doing this one, I will speak on a different subject.

The challenge of a sermon is the audience. Are they lost souls who need to believe? Are they believers who need to repent and be baptized? Are they young in Christ who need to grow in the Spirit? Are they

seasoned disciples who have grown cold? Are they saints who are spiritually mature beyond the speaker? The answer to all is YES! Every week a mixed group comes to seek answers to their varied questions.

Others want to be entertained and if the preacher is not up to their level of dynamic speaking, he is not listened to, even if they are sitting in the assembly. No preacher wants to be dull and uninteresting, some are, and some are even if just occasionally.

Changes in culture mean preachers need to adjust. No, the message is not changed, but people have. The time of entering the market square and drawing a crowd as the apostle Paul did. is over. It is difficult to compete with TV programs that have dozens of people and thousands of dollars. We come to expect that in a preacher, but also want him to do a dozen other things.

It's Strange


- It's strange how twenty dollars seems like such a large amount when you donate it to church, but such a small amount when you go shopping.
