The **Tabernacle Experience** will be in our parking lot from **April 12-21**. It is a full size replica of the Tabernacle used by Israel during the time in the wilderness, based on the descriptions and dimensions given in the book of Exodus. Replicas of the alter and the Ark of the Covenant create an awesome time of almost being transported to the past.

A major effort will be made to tell our city of this event. Invitations will be sent to all religious groups as well as to radio and TV stations for Public Service announcements. Social Media will be used also. Other Host churches have had thousands of neighbors to attend during the ten day exhibit.

If you have ever invited someone to attend worship with you and they asked, "where is the church?" You understand the value of being known in our community. How much better to have your friend say, "That's where the Tabernacle Exhibit was!"

The Tour of the Tabernacle takes about an hour. Two people will share a audio player and wear headsets for listening. The audio will be in English or Spanish.

The trailer will arrive from California on Thursday, April 11. There will be a small crew to instruct 20 volunteers to set up the Exhibit. Your help will be needed and feel free to invite friends to help set it up. There will also be a need to have 20 able bodied to do the take down on Mon, April 22.

The Exhibit is open from Noon to 7 p.m. everyday for ten days, April 12-21. There is a need for Volunteers to be present for four hour shifts: 12-4, 4-8. Both shifts will need seven people to be: Welcome attendant, Host Attendant, Audio Attendant, Courtyard Attendant, Holy Place Attendant, Audio Retriever, Marketplace Attendant. Ladies or men may serve. Attendants do not go with guests as they tour the Tabernacle. Please sign up for multiple days. Two people will be needed overnight each evening for security.

The Tabernacle Experience could be a big boost, but your help is needed to make it the success we need. PRAY for everyone and everything about this event. This can be a great opportunity to reach people for Jesus. I implore you to get involved and help this be the success it can be.



God's provision while we wait

A November 2023 landslide trapped 41 construction workers in a tunnel they'd been excavating for a Himalayan highway project. For 17 days, they were stranded nearly 3 miles from freedom. When rescuers' drilling equipment broke, miners drilled through the last 2 meters of rock and gravel by hand. Finally, all the workers were pulled to safety through a 3-foot-wide steel pipe. Because they had received food, water, medicines, oxygen and even light through a narrow pipe while underground, all were in good health.

We are trapped in sin and brokenness: our sin and that of others, fragmented relationships and systems, nearby and across the globe. Christianity teaches that God's way of goodness will win in the end. But before full rescue comes, what keeps us alive and hopeful — even healthy?


As water was faithfully provided to the laborers through that narrow pipe, God quenches our thirst through baptism. Scripture and the sacrament of communion are the food and medicine that nourish and strengthen us. Prayer — our own and others' prayers for us — along with the Holy Spirit's gifts such as comfort and joy flow into our lives like the light of hope and the oxygen of life. Though complete rescue seems slow to come, God provides for us while we wait. —Heidi Hyland Mann
