Sunday Morning Sermon Speaker - Charles Clodfelter Sermon: God's Grace, Present, Future

Scripture: Rom 5:17-18

YOUR GIVING MATTERS

Giving is a difficult topic of discussion for most preachers. A reason for this is because in small groups the offering is barely enough to pay the preacher's weekly stipend. Another is that some members are under the impression that the preacher goes through the checks and knows how much everyone is giving. Still another is the general idea that it is too personal.

It has been noted that there are more scriptures on giving than on baptism. This suggests giving is an important subject to God. Giving Matters to God.

The Old Testament reveals that God required those who believed and followed him to give. Under the Mosical period you frequently read of the tithe which Israel was required to give. The tithe was ten percent of the increase, on closer inspection you will discover there were three tithes commanded for Israel. Two were annual and the third was every third year, coming to a total of 23 percent. Additionally, they gave free

will offerings for thanksgiving, special events or blessings, etc. All of which would greatly increase the amount by total and percentage. Giving matter to God.


A tabulation of IRS tax forms reveals that middle wage earners average 4% or less, those under 25K give around 12% and those above 200K under 3%, those above 2 million 5% +. This is for all non-profits or charities, some of which spend upwards to 90% of their donations in fund raising.

Can you imagine on the Day of Pentecost in Acts chapter two that some devote Jew is born again into the Kingdom of Christ and is rejoicing that his giving has been reduced from 23% plus to only 5%? No, I can't either.

Giving is a reflection of our love for God, not about paying the utilities or the preacher. It reflects our commitment to the cause of the kingdom of Christ.

In the introduction to his book *For All God's Worth*, theologian N.T. Wright says, "Christmas is God lighting a candle, and you don't light a candle in a room that's already full of sunlight. You light a candle in a room that's so murky that the candle, when lit, reveals just how bad things really are. The light shines in the darkness, says St. John, and the darkness has not overcome it."

For that reason, Wright explains, Christmas isn't a dream or a momentary escape but reality. And the same is true for Christianity. "Either Jesus is the Lord of the world and all reality makes sense in his life, or he is dangerously irrelevant to the problems and possibilities of today's world," he adds. "There is no middle ground. Either Jesus was, and is, the Word of God, or he, and the stories Christians tell about him, are lies.
