

Sunday Morning Sermon Speaker - Charles Clodfelter Sermon: Grace of Forgiveness

Scripture: Eph 4:32-5:1



Dominion

The last creation by YHWH was humankind. Then it is recorded in Gen 1:26 and 28 that humanity is to have control or Dominion over all that God created. Different translations have also used the words Rule, Reign and Responsible. The mind and intelligence of mankind has brought us to the remarkable age in which we live. Who can imagine what the next 100 or 1,000 years will bring?

In 1889, Charles H. Duell, the Commissioner of US patent office, is widely quoted as having stated that the patent office would soon shrink in size, and eventually close, because... "Everything that can be invented has been invented." Whether Duell said it or not, the next 125 years has definitely proven the statement as wrong.

While the understanding is there for us to develop and use our world, a broader and deeper meaning is that we are responsible for our lives. We have control via the decisions we make. Neither you nor I had a role in harnessing the power of fire or electricity. But, we do take decisions that set the course of our life.


