It has always been the mission of the New Testament church to reach lost souls with the Gospel of Christ. It has always been a challenge. It is a challenge because most are comfortable in their present situation.

The first century Apostles and Disciples had challenges because people worshiped idols and in general idol worship centered around physical pleasures. However, they thought they were doing the right thing and were committed to the religion of their god.

Today the church is also challenged. It some ways the challenge is the same and in some ways it is different. Cultural change is constant. As someone said, "The only thing that stays the same is change." The church needs to adjust to changes in culture without changing the message of Jesus.

Change can be difficult for a people who believe the inspired of Word should be closely followed. The difficultly comes in seeing the distinction in tradition and scriptural doctrine. This is not always as easy as one would tend to think. When all we have known is a certain practice, changing it in some way seems wrong. This experience came when some congregations moved the observance of the Lord's Supper from before the sermon to after the sermon. When the largest church in Dallas decided to put in air conditioning in the 40's it caused an uproar.

When the apostles entered a city to preach they often performed miracles. These were to demonstrate the power of Jesus and give validity to the message they were preaching. But the miracles also drew attention and a crowd. The age of miracles passed with the apostles, but we can still do things to gain the attention of the citizens.

This does not require a violation of the Holy Word of God. It does require that we be innovative so we can draw the lost to hear the message of salvation. An activity can even be fun but if members do not participate or do not encourage outsiders to come with them, it fails in the purpose.

<u>The Tabernacle Experience</u> will be our opportunity to attract people and get their attention. It will require the full support of all of us to help and afterwards to follow up. It needs to be more than fun or interesting. Mark your calendar for April 11-22.





#### Learning to forgive From ChurchArtPro

Forgiveness is great in theory, and it's a wonderful blessing to receive. But granting forgiveness can be another story. As C.S. Lewis said, "Everybody says forgiveness is a lovely idea until they have something to forgive." Likewise, forgiveness doesn't simply happen over time, as forgetting often does. Instead, it's "an act of volition," said Simon Wiesenthal, "and only the sufferer is qualified to make the decision."

Because forgiveness has many spiritual, emotional and even physical benefits, the secular world is taking notice. Colleges now offer classes about forgiveness skills and strategies. "You practically never hear sermons on forgiveness that are practical and give clear instructions on how to approach it," Professor Robert Enright tells the Washington Post.

Graduate student Shyanne Sporrer says a forgiveness class helped her realize the danger of holding grudges. "Forgiving does not mean you are giving up power," she says. "On the contrary, when you forgive, you are the person who is in control. By

forgiving, you can empower yourself to move forward from the anger and resentment to be a better version of yourself."
