

Unconditional Election or selection by God is the only way mankind can be saved. Before you were born, in fact before the world was created, God decided if you or anyone would be saved. Predestination for protestant denominations hold to some of them. all. Determined by God and nothing man can do.

Limited Atonement is the idea that Jesus only died for those predestined to saved. He did not die for all.

Irresistible Grace means that you cannot tell God no. You have been chosen. When he makes you believe, you will saved. You cannot resist salvation

Perseverance of the Saints you cannot be lost. Some would say you can no longer sin, others would say you could sin all you wanted to and still be saved. Another way it is said is, Once saved, always saved.

Of course, they have scriptures which they believe support the points of Calvinism. Largely, the idea of Total Depravity is the concept that everyone is born the sovereignty of God is their point. God is all powerful and all knowing, so he must know. If he does not know, he is not sovereign, therefore not God.


